History. This circular (CIR) is an administrative revision. The portions affected by this administrative revision are listed in the summary of change.

Summary. This CIR sets hunting and fishing bag limits and seasons at Fort Hood.

Applicability. This CIR is available in electronic media only and is intended for the Regular Army, the Army National Guard/Army National Guard of the United States, and the U.S. Army Reserve; personnel assigned, attached, or employed by Fort Hood; and to all personnel authorized access to hunt, fish, or participate in general recreation activities at the Fort Hood military reservation including the bordering Corps of Engineers land extending to the shoreline of Belton Reservoir. Penalties for violations of this CIR apply to military and civilian personnel and include the full range of statutory and regulatory sanctions, encompassing criminal prosecution under the Uniform Code of Military Justice for personnel subject to its provisions, as well as adverse administrative action and other adverse actions authorized by applicable sections of the United States Code, Texas Parks and Wildlife (TPWD), and U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

Supplementation. Local supplementation of this CIR is prohibited without prior approval of the Directorate of Public Works (DPW).

Suggested improvements. Users are invited to send comments and suggested improvements on DA Form 2028 (Recommended Changes to Publications and Blank Forms) directly to the Commander, United States Army Garrison, ATTN: AMIM-HDP-E, Fort Hood, Texas 76544-5002.

Cantonment B (Kids Pond)	Boats or flotation devices are prohibited at all times. Pond is designated as kids- only fishing. All adults must be accompanied by at least one (1) fishing child 16 years old or younger.		
East Lake	Catch and release only. No fish from this pond may be kept for consumption. All fish must be released. This pond is a permitted facility.		
Birdbath Lake	Catch and release only. No fish from this pond may be kept for consumption. All fish must be released. This pond is a permitted facility.		
Landfill Lake	Per III Armored Corps Garrison Safety, fishing is not permitted in Landfill Lake.
