- 2. SUMMARY. This Circular (CIR) sets hunting and fishing bag limits and seasons at Fort Cavazos.
- 3. APPLICABILITY. This Circular (CIR) applies to anyone hunting, fishing, or participating in general recreation activities at Fort Cavazos.
- 4. SUPPLEMENTATION. Local supplementation of this regulation is prohibited without prior approval of the Directorate of Public Works (DPW).

#### a. Hunting controls:

This section outlines controls on weapons, seasons, hours of shooting, and possession limits at Fort Cavazos. Allowances do not exceed those established by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD).
